**Fasting and Abstinence from meat on Good Friday**  
 Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence from meat for Catholics. Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are for those age 14 and up. (mostly from USCCB).
