The One Year Anniversary of the Overturning of Roe v. Wade

June 24th marks the one-year anniversary of the Supreme Court's decision in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization, which overturned Roe v. Wade. As we approach this anniversary, we continue to offer thanksgiving to God that states can once again protect the lives of preborn children in law. In God's profound providence, the Court handed down its historic decision on the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and during the month that we also celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Since the Dobbs decision, many states have enacted strong pro-life protections. Tragically, other states have drastically expanded abortion access. As a result of the Kansas Supreme Court's Hodes decision and the failure to pass Value Them Both, virtually unlimited and unregulated abortion is now protected under the Kansas Constitution. While the Kansas Legislature can no longer pass laws that limit or regulate abortion, it can and did pass pro-life legislation designed to assist women and babies in need, overcoming three Gov. At this critical moment, we are presented with new opportunities and responsibilities to continue building a culture that welcomes and celebrates life. Let us each draw close to Christ's Sacred Heart in the Eucharist and sincerely ask how He is calling us to use our unique gifts for the cause of life.
