# FOURTH WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY – SEPT. 8

The World Day for Grandparents and Elderly is observed in the United States on the first Sunday after Labor Day, Sept. 8. The theme for this year's celebration is "Do not cast me off in my old age" (cf. Psalm 71:9), wishes to call attention to the fact that, sadly, loneliness is the bitter lot in the lives of many elderly, so often the victims of the throw-away culture. He has invited everyone "to show our tender love for grandparents and the elderly members of our families."

#### **Constitution Week Sept 17-23**

To commemorate the signing of the U.S. Constitution, the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) petitioned Congress to set aside September 17-23, annually, to be dedicated for the observance of Constitution Week. In 1956, President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed the resolution into public law. Since passage of this resolution, DAR has undertaken numerous activities to promote better understanding of the Constitution and to celebrate it via student educational programs, library displays, public signage, state/city/county proclamations, flying of the flag, a national poster contest, encouraging individuals to share something about the constitution with family and friends, and church bell ringing as part of the "Bells Across America" celebration, among other activities. The First Amendment of our Constitution protects our Freedom of Religion, Speech, Press, Petition, and Assembly.
