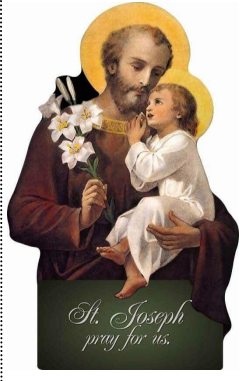
**UPCOMING MEETING MINISTRY FOR PARENTS WHO HAVE LOST A CHILD**

**Year of St. Joseph!**



Every so often the Church declares a year dedicated to a special focus. Recently, we have had the Year of Mercy, Year of Faith, Year of Priests, and Year of St. Paul. Now, on the 150th Anniversary of declaring St. Joseph Patron of the Universal Church, the Church has declared a Year of St. Joseph. Pope Pius IX made that patron declaration on Dec. 8th, 1870.

The Year of St. Joseph will go from Dec. 8th, 2020 to Dec. 8th, 2021!

**The "Value Them Both" petition**

The new Kansas Legislature is likely to vote soon on the Value Them Both Kansas Constitution Amendment. We will begin to pray for the successful passage of Value Them Both with a petition during the Prayers of the Faithful. What is VALUE THEM BOTH? VTB is the proposed state constitutional amendment for life supported by the Catholic Bishops of Kansas. On April 26, 2019, the Kansas Supreme Court created a nearly unlimited "right" to abortion in the 1859 Kansas Constitution which continues to allow the live dismemberment of preborn children in our state. Due to this ruling, all of our existing pro-life laws including bans on taxpayer-funded and late-term abortions will be considered unconstitutional once challenged. The VALUE THEM BOTH amendment will reverse the Supreme Court ruling and once again allow Kansans, through their elected representatives, to pass laws that will help protect women and their unborn babies from the abortion industry. Please pray for passage of VALUE THEM BOTH.
