**Plenary Indulgence for deceased available all of November. Visit a Cemetery**  
 To obtain the plenary indulgence any time during November, visit a Cemetery, pray for a deceased person (Eternal Rest Prayer), and receive Communion and sacramental Confession (and have no attachment to sin, even venial). Communion is received each day we wish to gain the indulgence for a deceased person, but we only need to go to Confession once within about 20 days before or after the indulgences. And, as with all plenary indulgences, we must pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary) each day we perform the work of the Indulgence.

**The Meaning of Advent Candles**  
 As a Christian tradition, the wreath holds the four Advent candles. The candles represent Jesus coming as the light in darkness. One candle is lit each Sunday until all four candles are lit, and sometimes a fifth candle is lit on Christmas. As Christmas draws nearer, each candle brings a little more light into the darkness.

**Each of the candles represents an aspect of preparation during the season of Advent:**

**The Candle of Hope**  
 Color: Purple  
 Purple is the primary color associated with Advent. Within the Catholic Church it symbolizes penance, preparation, and sacrifice. During the first week of Advent, we look forward to Jesus' coming with hope.

**The Candle of Peace**  
 Color: Purple  
 During this second week of Advent, we reflect on our lives and work on becoming better-versions-of-ourselves in preparation for Jesus' coming.

**The Candle of Joy**  
 Color: Rose  
 This third candle is rose, symbolizing anticipation and rejoicing. During the third week of Advent, we are filled with joy for the near arrival of Jesus on Christmas day.

**The Candle of Love**  
 Color: Purple  
 During this final week of Advent we rejoice in the endless love that God has for us, which is made apparent in the birth of his Son: "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." - John 3:16
