**THE IDEAL OF THE MI**

The principal characteristic of Kolbe's consecration is unlimitedness. The outward sign of consecration is the Miraculous Medal. Though it is not essential, it is the integral sign and condition for our consecration. The Founder of the Immaculata wrote, "The ideal of every member of the M.I. is to be the servant and child of the Immaculate, and this out of love, as a slave, as her property and possession, irrevocably and forever. It is our ideal to become Her own."

Kolbe strove for an identification with the Immaculata. He strove to imitate her in her openness to the Holy Spirit, her continuous "Yes" to God, and her perfect discipleship of Christ. By consecrating himself to the Immaculata, he believed that this was how he could give the greatest glory to God, through her who was God's most perfect creation and which none better could or ever would exist as taught by the Franciscan theologian, Saint Bonaventure.
