Yes, seriously! It is actually one of the safest ways to still continue with making the Sacrament available at this time. It is certainly not ideal but it can work so you can still receive the Sacrament. The Archdiocese in their new guidelines suggests this as a possibility.

How it works?  
 All regularly scheduled private confession times will now be outside. I will set up a chair in the parking lot. Just look for me.

(I'll be in my car if it is raining).  
 When it is your turn drive up while maintaining the recommended 6 feet distance.  
 Other cars should stay back until their turn so as not to hear what is said.  
 If there are several people in the same car such as kids, you can park and walk up to me one by one while maintaining the six feet distance between us for both of our safety.  
 (Bring an umbrella just in case!)  
 Thanks for your patience and understanding during these difficult times.
