 Greetings to all!,
 As we begin back with Masses during the weekend and weekday, please know that you are welcome but do not have to come if you decide it would be best not to at this time. The obligation for Sunday/Saturday eve Mass is still lifted by Archbishop until further notice. If you are at risk you may want to consider still staying at home. Those who are sick please do stay home as well as anyone exposed to the coronavirus recently. For those that come, please wear a mask (outdoor Mass perhaps not needed but still can do so). We will have some extra masks available if needed at Church. Please social distance from other households by staying 6 feet away at all times including going and coming, seating, and at Communion. If you would like to receive Communion, you can remove your mask while the person in front of you receives. Be careful not to touch the middle of the mask where germs can be. After you have received Communion you can step to the side and place your mask on and then return to your pew. People can go pew by pew in a single line for Communion.  Car Wash for your Soul!**
 Yes, seriously! It is actually one of the safest ways to still continue with making the Sacrament available at this time. It is certainly not ideal but it can work so you can still receive the Sacrament. The Archdiocese in their new guidelines suggests this as a possibility.
 How it works?
 All regularly scheduled private confession times will now be outside. I will set up a chair in the parking lot. Just look for me.
(I'll be in my car if it is raining).
 When it is your turn drive up while maintaining the recommended 6 feet distance. Other cars should stay back until their turn so as not to hear what is said.
 If there are several people in the same car such as kids, you can park and walk up to me one by one while maintaining the six feet distance between us for both of our safety.
(Bring an umbrella just in case!)

SAINT PHILIP NERI (1515-1595)
May 26
 In a shop near the Vatican, a group of Americans laughed as the shopkeeper showed off his fluent English and latest souvenir, a key ring whose papal portrait, when pressed, activated a recorded blessing. Through the shop window, two clerics scowled disapproval. The shopkeeper grunted, "They're a very somber order who've left the Church. I recognize them." "By their long robes?" an American asked. "Many in Rome wear robes," replied the shopkeeper. "It's their long faces!" When Philip Neri arrived in sixteenth-century Rome, there was reason to be somber. Swiss Guards had been massacred on Saint Peter's steps defending the pope. Parts of Europe were abandoning the Church. But Philip resolved to be an "apostle of joy," drawing especially the young to Christ—and frequent confession and Communion—by his sincere interest in their problems, prayerful example, and gentle humor. His "Oratory," a movement as well as a place, provided recreation and devotion in a joyful atmosphere of companionship, service, and liturgy.
