For leaders and people in positions of responsibility great and small, that during this pandemic they will make decisions to support the value and dignity of human life above other concerns, let us pray to the Lord.

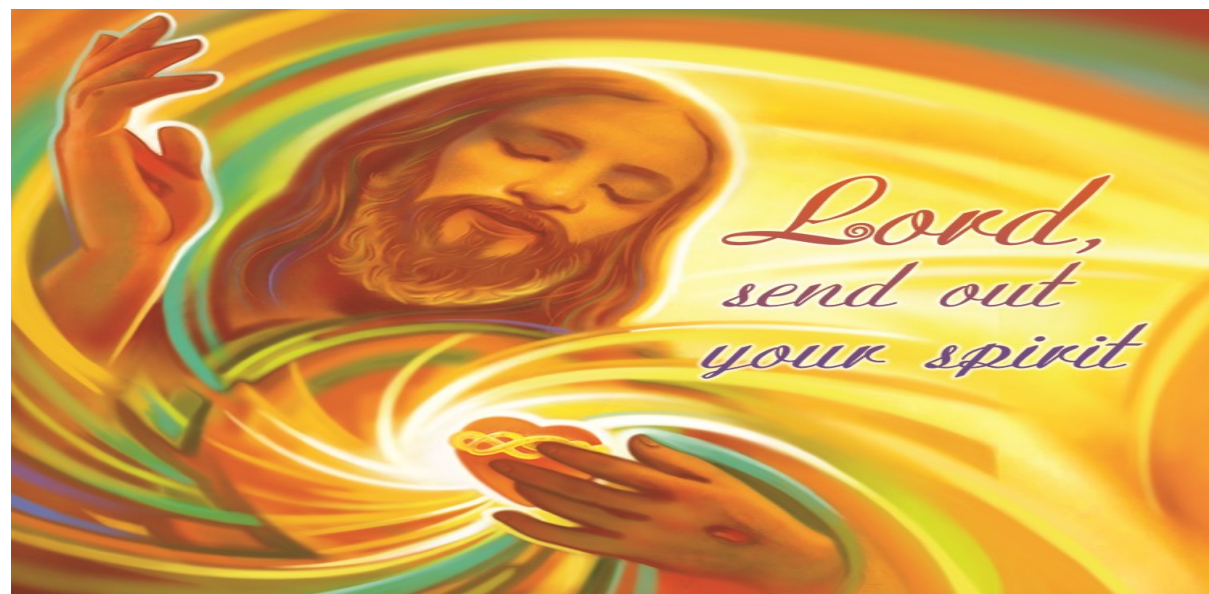
For those among us who have been marginalized by our society, for the poor, the homeless, and those victimized by the substances that they have abused, let us pray to the Lord.

 Greetings to all!,
 As we begin back with Masses during the weekend and weekday, please know that you are welcome but do not have to come if you decide it would be best not to at this time. The obligation for Sunday/Saturday eve Mass is still lifted by Archbishop until further notice. If you are at risk you may want to consider still staying at home. Those who are sick please do stay home as well as anyone exposed to the coronavirus recently. For those that come, please wear a mask (outdoor Mass perhaps not needed but still can do so). We will have some extra masks available if needed at Church. Please social distance from other households by staying 6 feet away at all times including going and coming, seating, and at Communion. If you would like to receive Communion, you can remove your mask while the person in front of you receives. Be careful not to touch the middle of the mask where germs can be. After you have received Communion you can step to the side and place your mask on and then return to your pew. People can go pew by pew in a single line for Communion. Please depart pew by pew starting from the back when leaving. The collection basket will be at the back that you can drop a donation in coming or going. Thank you for your support. You can bring a misalette Mass guide of your own or use your phone to follow along with the Mass. If you have any extra cleaning supplies, we may have a need for them with cleaning the Church. Drive Thru Confession! Car Wash for your Soul!
 Yes, seriously! It is actually one of the safest ways to still continue with making the Sacrament available at this time. It is certainly not ideal but it can work so you can still receive the Sacrament. The Archdiocese in their new guidelines suggests this as a possibility. How it works? All regularly scheduled private confession times will now be outside. I will set up a chair in the parking lot. Just look for me. **(I'll be in my car if it is raining).**
 When it is your turn drive up while maintaining the recommended 6 feet distance. Other cars should stay back until their turn so as not to hear what is said. If there are several people in the same car such as kids, you can park and walk up to me one by one while maintaining the six feet distance between us for both of our safety. **(Bring an umbrella just in case!)**

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION
 Before there was water, there was fire. Once in a while, a volcano hints at the sizzling magma upon which the whole human enterprise floats. Over eons, the surface cooled off a bit, and rain sizzled down for thousands of centuries, filling the oceans and sculpting the earth. We Christians can catch God's glory in a shimmering pool of water, but we can also capture God's burning desire to fan the tiny flames of our baptismal candles into something that will make a difference.
 In Sicily to this day, there is a custom of scattering rose petals down from the ceiling of church on the heads of the faithful, an effective reminder of the "tongues of flame" descending on the apostles, and a sign that the Holy Spirit still is poured out on the baptized. It is not merely a quaint custom, but a fairly potent sign of what baptism does. An interesting sidebar: if you have traced the Epiphany blessing on your doorway in chalk, Pentecost is the day to erase it. From now on, no need to rely on the "wise men"—you are alive in the Spirit!
