Taking the census is a civic duty, and impacts support for infrastructure, transportation planning, emergency preparedness, disaster relief, education funding, health tracking and disease control, as well as a multitude of other things. **Voter Registration for the 2020 Election**  
 Election Day is Tuesday, November 3rd 2020. In order to be able to vote, you must be registered. The deadline to register to vote is Tuesday, October 13th. You can register at [www.kdor.ks.gov/Apps/VoterReg](http://www.kdor.ks.gov/Apps/VoterReg). It is important to register especially if you recently turned 18, recently moved or had a name change, have not voted in recent elections, or if you are unsure if you have registered. As Catholics, we are called not simply to vote, but to be well informed voters who in casting our ballots apply the moral principles and priorities of our Faith. The Catholic Church does not tell its members how to vote. At the same time, it is the responsibility of the Church to help form the consciences of her members to understand the principles and priorities that should guide their decisions as voters.
